Spear Shaft – 185 cm/6ft 1 in, criss cross leather binding top and bottom

Drinking horn – 7.5cm/3 ins rim diameter, ½ pint, 0.3 litre capacity

Lantern – wood and parchment, 28cm/11 ins tall, 17.5cm/7 ins base diameter

Small penanular – brass, white metal pin, 3cm/1.25 ins diameter

Cloaks

Green (with steel penanular), 200 x 163 cm/79 x 64 ins

Green check/purple reverse, fur trimmed, 140 x 112 cm/55 x 44 ins

Kirtles

Very dark grey, tablet braid on cuffs and neck, wool

Mid- grey, no decoration, wool

Spur – brass, leather thronging

Gloves

1 left, 1 right, padded (not a pair)

2 left, unpadded

Tablet braid - 1.5 cm/ 3/8 inch wide, 88 cm/ 34 ins long, blue/white/green

Machine braid – 1.5cm/0.5 ins wide, 2 x 1m lengths, black, white, red and green

Modern

Metal flask in blue authentic bag

Bar from 'lock fast' caravan wheel lock (fell off caravan as it left site)
