

Trading at Hastings₂₀₀₆

NO TRADING WHATSOEVER WILL BE ALLOWED WITHIN THE LHE.

This includes those authentic traders who produce goods authentically on site and who are therefore usually allowed in the village. It also includes small volume traders who don't normally have a proper pitch as such, and/or those who only sell to other re-enactors. No-one is allowed to sell anything commercially within the LHE.

English Heritage have decreed that all traders must be in traders row and none are allowed in the village/LHE. The LHE will be regularly inspected and anyone flaunting these rules is liable to be removed from site, or at least required to relocate and pay pitch fees

Traders cannot register via the Hastings website, they must personally contact EH / Alysha.

We are advised that traders row will have an authentic section and a Modern section. Authentic traders will be given a free pitch in an authentic section of traders row. Modern traders will have to pay a pitch fee. You will have to discuss with English Heritage which category your stall falls into and will be sited and charged accordingly.
